1. Approved. Readdressed and forwarded.

2. As indicated in encl (1), the respondent's court-martial was returned to the CO, MWSG-17 for appropriate actions. In lieu of a rehearing the CO, MWSG-17 chose to process the respondent for administrative separation. The respondent waived his right to an administrative board hearing on his acknowledgment of rights form providing he received a general (under honorable conditions) characterization. Based on the foregoing proceedings and a review of the Respondent's Service Record Book, per chapter six of reference (a), I direct that the Respondent be separated with a general characterization of service for the commission of a serious offense.

3. As the respondent is currently on involuntary appellate leave, I further direct the Commanding Officer, Marine Wing Support Group 17 to establish liaison with the Wing Personnel Officer to initiate action to transfer the Respondent from Navy and Marine Corps Appellate Leave Activity to an appropriate separations site for a discharge with a reenlistment code of RE-4 and a separation code of HKQ1.
