SUBJECT: *Ex Post Facto* Good Conduct Time Analysis – Prisoner Charles Graner

With the approval of Ms. Gail H. McGinn, performing the duties of the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness, the attachment to Directive Type Memorandum subject: Clarification of DoD Policy on Abatement of Sentences to Confinement, September 17, 2004, should be corrected as follows:

“A2.2.2 With respect to offenses committed prior to January 1, 2005, GCT shall be awarded at the rates specified in DoD Instruction 1325.7, enclosure 26.”

The sentences of all persons now in the control of the Department of Defense, including those who have been transferred to the Federal Bureau of Prisons, with offenses committed prior to January 1, 2005, but who were sentenced on or after January 1, 2005, should be modified to reflect the more generous Good Conduct Time rates possible under DoD Instruction 1325.7, enclosure 26.
