Dear Representative Moran:

I am responding to your recent letter concerning the military record of Michael M. O'Brien. This Agency has oversight authority for the Army Board for Correction of Military Records (ABCMR).

We received Mr. O'Brien's appeal on December 28, 2009. Mr. O'Brien's appeal is important to us. However, we process over 15,000 applications a year and we want to make sure each one is thoroughly analyzed and fairly reviewed. Based on this volume and our commitment to justice, the completion time for most applications is approximately 12 months. The ABCMR processes applications in the order they are received. Unfortunately, we do not have the capability to track where Mr. O'Brien's appeal is in this process or when it will be completed. I have filed your letter and enclosures in Mr. O'Brien's case file. The Board will notify both your office and Mr. O'Brien of its decision.

I trust this information is helpful.
