Specification 1: In that Staff Sergeant Joshua E. Hawk, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near San Diego, California, on or about 15 October 2008, with intent to deceive, make to Special Agent Rick Rendon of the Naval Criminal Ivestigative Service, an official statement, to wit: September 2008 at MCRD Ms. Emiliana L.
