CHARGE III: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 133

Specification 1: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near New Orleans, Louisiana, on or about 3 April 2007, acted in a manner unbecoming of an officer and gentlemen, to wit: by wrongfully engaging in sexual intercourse with Ms. Jessica Brooder while he knew, or should have known that Ms. Brooder was so significantly intoxicated and mentally and physically impaired as a result of said intoxication that a reasonable officer in the Naval service would have recognized that there was a substantial likelihood that she was incapable of knowingly and voluntarily consenting to sexual intercourse.

Specification 2: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near New Orleans, Louisiana, on or about 3 April 2007, acted in a manner unbecoming of an officer and gentlemen, to wit: by wrongfully attempting to engage in sexual intercourse with Ms. Elizabeth Easley while he knew or should have known that Ms. Easley was so significantly intoxicated and mentally and physically impaired as a result of said intoxication that a reasonable officer in the Naval service would have recognized that there was a substantial likelihood that she was incapable of knowingly and voluntarily consenting to sexual intercourse.

Specification 3: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near Seattle, Washington, on or about December 2006, acted in a manner unbecoming of an officer and gentlemen, to wit: by wrongfully engaging in sexual intercourse with Ms. Nicole Cusack while he knew or should have known that Ms. Cusack was so significantly intoxicated and mentally and physically impaired as a result of said intoxication that a reasonable officer in the Naval service would have recognized that there was a substantial likelihood that she was incapable of knowingly and voluntarily consenting to sexual intercourse.

Specification 4: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near San Diego, California, between on or about November 2007 and July 2008, acted in a manner unbecoming of an officer and gentlemen, to wit: By wrongfully endeavoring to impede an investigation in the case of Captain Douglas S. Wacker, by asking Mr. Amos Lowder to speak to Ms. Nicole Cusack and tell her, a potential victim in the case, to not talk to anyone about Captain Wacker's ongoing case with Ms. Easley and Ms. Brooder, or words to that effect.

Specification 5: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near San Diego, California, between on or about November 2007 and January 2009, acted in a manner unbecoming of an officer and gentlemen, to wit: By wrongfully endeavoring to impede an investigation in the case of Captain Douglas S. Wacker, by asking Mr. Gorman to provide false statements to Special Agent J.R. Burge, Naval Criminal Investigative Service, an investigating officer in the case of Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps.

CHARGE IV: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 134

Specification 1: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near San Diego, California, from about November 2007 to about January 2009, on diverse occasions, wrongfully endeavor to influence the testimony of Joseph Gorman, as a witness before Special Agent J.R. Burge, Naval Criminal Investigative Service, an investigating officer in the case of Captain Douglas S. Wacker, U.S. Marine Corps, by asking Joseph Gorman to provide false statements to the said investigating officer.

Specification 2: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near San Diego, California, from about November 2007 to about July 2009, wrongfully endeavor to impede the investigation in the case of Captain Douglas S. Wacker, U.S. Marine Corps, investigated by Special Agent J.R. Burge, Naval Criminal Investigative Service, by asking Mr. Amos Lowder to speak with Ms. Nicole Cusack, a potential victim, to keep Ms. Nicole Cusack quiet and to tell her to not talk to anyone about Captain Wacker's ongoing case with Ms. Elizabeth Easley and Ms. Jessica Brooder, or words to that effect.

Specification 3: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near New Orleans, Louisiana, on or about 3 April 2007, commit an indecent assault upon Ms. Elizabeth Easley, a person not his wife by undressing her, kissing her neck and chest area, with the intent to gratify his sexual desires.
