- 1. Pursuant to References (a) through (f), the Government hereby provides notice of information requested by the 3rd Defense Request for Discovery dated 20 August 2010, which the Government granted and agreed to provide as soon as the information became available:
 - a. [Paragraph 1.g.] Granted. No results were found.
- b. [Paragraph 1.h.] Granted. Previously transmitted to Defense.
- c. [Paragraph 1.i.] Granted. Previously transmitted to Defense.
- d. [Paragraph 1.o.] Granted. SSgt Mattson received district-level NJP for the incident with Alicia Clanton, a page 11 entry for the NJP, non-recommended to GySgt, and termination of his special duty assignment pay.
- 2. The above response constitutes all information known to the Government through due diligence at the time this response was transmitted. Should any of the requested information become known to the Government subsequent to this response, it will be furnished to the Defense as soon as possible.
- 3. The Government requests reciprocal discovery as required by Reference (a) and applicable case law, including but not limited to:

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- a. Notification and disclosure of any documentary evidence the Defense has obtained independently and intends to present during its case on the merits, during cross examination of Government witnesses, or on sentencing.
- b. Notification and disclosure of any evidence (of any kind) regarding prior sexual history of witnesses the Defense intends to use during its case on the merits, during cross examination of Government witnesses, or on sentencing.
- 4. As noted in R.C.M. 701(d), this request continues before and during trial.
