

AN ACT

To authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2011 for military activities of the Department of Defense, for military construction, and for defense activities of the Department of Energy, to prescribe military personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and for other purposes.

1 **SEC. 534. DISPOSITION OF MEMBERS FOUND TO BE FIT**
2 **FOR DUTY WHO ARE NOT SUITABLE FOR DE-**
3 **PLOYMENT OR WORLDWIDE ASSIGNMENT**
4 **FOR MEDICAL REASONS.**

5 (a) DISPOSITION.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 61 of title 10,
7 United States Code, is amended by inserting after
8 section 1214 the following new section:

9 **“§ 1214a. Members determined fit for duty in Phys-**
10 **ical Evaluation Board evaluation: prohi-**
11 **bition on involuntary administrative sep-**
12 **aration due to unsuitability based on**
13 **medical conditions considered in evalua-**
14 **tion**

15 “(a) DISPOSITION.—Except as provided in subsection
16 (c), the Secretary of the military department concerned
17 may not authorize the involuntary administrative separa-
18 tion of a member described in subsection (b) based on a
19 determination that the member is unsuitable for deploy-
20 ment or worldwide assignment based on the same medical
21 condition of the member considered by a Physical Evalua-
22 tion Board during the evaluation of the member.

23 “(b) COVERED MEMBERS.—A member covered by
24 subsection (a) is any member of the armed forces who has
25 been determined by a Physical Evaluation Board pursuant
26 to a physical evaluation by the board to be fit for duty.

1 “(c) REEVALUATION.—(1) The Secretary of the mili-
2 tary department concerned may direct the Physical Eval-
3 uation Board to reevaluate any member described in sub-
4 section (b) if the Secretary has reason to believe that a
5 medical condition of the member considered by the Phys-
6 ical Evaluation Board during the evaluation of the mem-
7 ber described in that subsection renders the member un-
8 suitable for continued military service based on the med-
9 ical condition.

10 “(2) A member determined pursuant to reevaluation
11 under paragraph (1) to be unfit to perform the duties of
12 the member’s office, grade, rank, or rating may be retired
13 or separated for physical disability under this chapter.

14 “(3) The Secretary of Defense shall be the final ap-
15 proval authority for any case determined by the Secretary
16 of a military department to warrant administrative separa-
17 tion based on a determination that the member is un-
18 suitable for continued service due to the same medical con-
19 dition of the member considered by a Physical Evaluation
20 Board that found the member fit for duty.”.

21 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-
22 tions at the beginning of chapter 61 of such title is
23 amended by inserting after the item relating to sec-
24 tion 1214 the following new item:

“1214a. Members determined fit for duty in Physical Evaluation Board evaluation: prohibition on involuntary administrative separation due to unsuitability based on medical conditions considered in evaluation.”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
3 ment of this Act, and shall apply with respect to members
4 evaluated for fitness for duty by Physical Evaluation
5 Boards on or after that date.

6 **SEC. 535. REVIEW OF LAWS, POLICIES, AND REGULATIONS**
7 **RESTRICTING SERVICE OF FEMALE MEM-**
8 **BERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

9 (a) REVIEW REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Defense,
10 in coordination with the Secretaries of the military depart-
11 ments, shall conduct a review of laws, policies, and regula-
12 tions, including the collocation policy, that may restrict
13 the service of female members of the Armed Forces to de-
14 termine whether changes in such laws, policies, and regu-
15 lations are needed to ensure that female members have
16 an equitable opportunity to compete and excel in the
17 Armed Forces.

18 (b) SUBMISSION OF RESULTS.—Not later than April
19 15, 2011, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the
20 congressional defense committees a report containing the
21 results of the review.

Thank you for your inquiry of December 9, 2010, on behalf of Petty Officer Second Class Sandra E. DeMunnik, United States Navy, regarding her desire to be retained in the Navy.

Your desire to assist Petty Officer DeMunnik is appreciated. Petty Officer DeMunnik was selected for Officer Candidate School (OCS) as a Public Affairs Officer and reported onboard Officer Training Command, Newport on December 9, 2010. While in OCS training, she developed a medical condition that disqualified her as an Officer Candidate. She was processed through the Disability Evaluation System and was found fit for duty by the Physical Evaluation Board; however, she is not considered worldwide assignable due to her existing medical condition.

Currently, Petty Officer DeMunnik has been issued Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders, a copy of which is enclosed. She will be retained in the Navy until her End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of December 11, 2012. She must screen as world-wide assignable by her EAOS or she will not be allowed to reenlist.

**Public Forum Comments to the DoD Recovering Warrior Task Force
Concerning the Department of the Navy's Disability Evaluation System
31 March 2011**

In March, the Task Force is exploring the Department of the Navy's Disability Evaluation System (DES). To be blunt, the Navy's DES is disingenuous and dishonest. The Navy has created several ways to cheat sailors and marines out of their DoD disability benefits. You can read the details of these disgraceful practices in my *DES Outrage* series posted on Pebforum.com¹.

Perhaps the most dishonest Navy technique is when the Physical Evaluation Board (PEB) finds an individual fit for duty and then the Navy or Marine Corps deems the member unsuitable for service and discharges them without DoD disability benefits.

After I wrote about the fit but unsuitable practice in DES Outrage Number 3², Congress took action and passed Section 534 of the 2011 National Defense Authorization Act. This law prevents the Services from administratively discharging members due to a condition a PEB deems fitting. In response to this law, the Department of the Navy simply adjusted tactics. They are continuing and expanding a similar technique that bars reenlistment due to the same condition a PEB deems fitting. This leads to separation, without DoD disability benefits, due to a service connected condition. In addition, since the fit but unsuitable law went into effect on 7 January, I have seen several cases where the Navy is simply refusing to submit wounded warriors to the DES as required by law and regulation. They are avoiding the fit but unsuitable discharge prohibition by simply avoiding fit findings.

You must ask the Navy and Marine Corps their positions on the fit but unsuitable issue. Specifically: Will they continue to deny reenlistment due to the same condition a PEB found to be fitting? Will they continue to deny disability evaluations to members required to undergo such evaluations? Under what circumstances do they believe they can deny disability evaluation under the DES?

I ask that the Task Force take a deep look into the Navy's dishonest DES practices by exploring the details of Sgt Roy Sanchez's disability case. This marine's disability case clearly points out the many techniques the Navy uses to cheat sailors and marines out of DoD disability benefits. You can find the details of Sgt Sanchez's case in *DES Outrages* 14³ and 16⁴.
