1. Nature of Notice.

Pursuant to the Supreme Court's ruling in *Giglio v. United*States, 405 U.S. 150 (1972), the Government provides the following disclosures to the Defense:

- (1) On 22 December 2011, Mr. Andrew Wright stated that in 2006, subsequent to the return of 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines from its Iraq deployment, that Sergeant Sanick Dela Cruz struck him in the face with a closed fist and said words to the effect of, "if I ever see you on the street, I will kill you."
- (2) Mr. Rene Rodriquez indicated to the Government during a telephonic interview on 27 December 2011 that he is receiving disability payments for PTSD.
- (3) Mr. Andrew Wright has also indicated to the Government that he was diagnosed with PTSD and attempted suicide while in Iraq.

3. Discussion.

The Government provides notice of disclosure to Defense counsel pursuant to Giglio v. United States (405 U.S. 150 (1972)). In Giglio, the Supreme Court found that the prosecution's failure to disclose evidence affecting the credibility of a material witness justified a new trial under the Due Process Clause. See id. The Government does not concede that any of the disclosures contained within are in fact Giglio disclosures but is providing them in an abundance of caution.
