EMERGENCY MOTION TO LIMIT THE EVIDENCE DEPOSITION OF LARRY CARVER

Plaintiff, Christopher S. Cynowa, by his attorneys Theresa V. Johnson and Peter V. Bustamante, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 211 and 213(f), moves this Honorable Court to limit the evidence deposition of Larry Carver and in support thereof states:

- 1. On March 18, 2011, the defendants served notice for the evidence deposition of Larry Carver, scheduled for March 29, 2011. A copy of the subpoena was served on counsel on March 21, 2011. A copy of the Notice and Subpoena are attached as Exhibit 1.
 - 2. Mr. Carver's deposition will be taken in Alexandria, Virginia.
 - 3. The defendants are calling Larry Carver as their witness in their case in chief.
- 4. Because of the time and expense that will be incurred in attending Mr. Carver's deposition, the plaintiff brings this motion to limit the issues to be addressed by the defendants with Mr. Carver, in conformance with the defendants' disclosures under Supreme Court Rule 213(f).
 - 5. In their 213(f) disclosures regarding Mr. Carver, the defendants state:

Further, Mr. Theobald will testify regarding Plaintiff's defamatory and commercially disparaging statements as to Ms. Wolford, Mr. Slater and CSSS and the damages that have been suffered. Mr. Theobald will also testify as to matters germane to CSSS human resources of employment issues. Mr. Theobald may be contacted through Defendants' counsel.

Lisa Wolford

Ms. Wolford will testify as to Plaintiff's Complaint and to Defendant's Counterclaim, along with the interrogatory answers and any 213(f)(1) disclosures prepared on her behalf. Ms. Wolford will also testify regarding Plaintiff's termination. Further, Ms. Wolford will testify

regarding Plaintiff's defamatory and commercially disparaging statements as to her and CSSS and the damages suffered. Ms. Wolford will also testify as to those matters raised in her deposition and the depositions of other people taken in this case. Ms. Wolford may be contacted through Defendants' counsel.




