- 1. <u>Preliminary Information</u>. Enclosure (1) is the Commanding Officer's recommendation to refer the charges and specifications contained in enclosure (2) to trial by general court-martial. Enclosure (3) contains Major Scarselli's waiver of his right to an Article 32 hearing. Enclosure (4) contains evidence of the offenses.
- 2. Staff Judge Advocate's Review. Pursuant to the requirements of references (a) and (b), I have reviewed enclosures (2) and (3) and found them to be in substantial compliance with reference (c). Based on my review of the enclosures, it is my opinion that:
- a. Each of the specifications under the charges alleges an offense under the UCMJ;
- b. The allegations of each of the offenses contained in enclosure (2) are warranted by evidence indicated in enclosure (4).
- c. A court-martial would have jurisdiction over the accused and the alleged offenses;
- d. The charges and specifications should be referred for trial by general court-martial.
