- 1. Pursuant to reference (a), enclosures (1) through (3) are provided as discovery.
- 2. In response to paragraph 1 of reference (b), the government provides the following:
- a. Your request is granted in part and denied in part. Responsive records related to your request are provided at enclosure (1) for Lieutenant Colonel Sullivan, and enclosure (2) for Major Gannon. Insofar as your request relates to Major Donald Plowman, the trial counsel is not aware of any responsive documents. Major Plowman retired in approximately May of 2010. Insofar as your request relates to Lieutenant Colonel Atterburry, responsive records exist, however, your request is denied on relevancy grounds. Lieutenant Colonel Atterbury is not detailed to the case of U.S. v. Wuterich.
- b. Your request for "any endorsement" associated with LtCol Sullivan and LtCol Atterburry is denied as you have not demonstrated the relevance of the requested materials. However, all responsive documents in the possession of the trial counsel will be delivered to the Military Judge for an *in camera* inspection.
- c. Please see paragraph 2a above. Responsive records are contained at enclosure (1).
- d. Please see paragraph 2a above. Responsive records are contained at enclosure (2).
- 3. In response to paragraph 2 of reference (b), the government provides the following:
 - a. LtCol Sullivan is denied as a witness
 - b. Major Gannon is denied as a witness

Nora,

I spoke with Col Ary and discussed my concerns with Maj Nick Gannon PCAing to a CAG billet at MCB CP and I requested that he be PCAd to MCB CP. My primary bases for this request are as follows:

- So that Maj Gannon can remain the OIC, LSST-E through the summer as a bridge for the significant turnover of field grade personnel, 5 of 6 majors at the LSSS.
- 2. Maj Gannon is part of the two-man trial team for the U.S. v. Wuterich case, the last of the Haditha cases. This case is scheduled to go to trial in the July/August timeframe. The plan has been to have this case completed prior to Maj Gannon's PCA.
- Maj Gannon is slated to deploy with 1st Bn, 1st Marines in the fall of 2010 after his PCA to base. This has been agreed upon by Col Jamison and LtCol Keith.

Based upon our conversation, it is my understanding that right now Capt Gruver and Capt Goode are the two Major selects slated to PCS to MCB CP. I would request for Capt Gruver to be moved to the CAG billet and for Maj Gannon to be placed in the MCB CP billet.

Also, FYSA, I talked about the issues Nick Martz has had with going to a CAG billet at 11th Marines (training requirements, billet responsibilities, etc.). Col Ary's comment was why are we sending a ELPer to a CAG billet for his second JA tour? I explained to him that you had been working with Maj Flynn on this issue. Col Ary also said that he was working on the LtCol slate and would look more closely at these issues once you had gotten through the LtCol piece.

Good luck with manpower, thank you again for letting me bend your ear, and let me know if you have any questions or concerns.

- 1. Per chapter 2 of the reference, I request a modification of my retirement date from 1 June 2008 to 1 July 2008.
- 2. I am a military defense counsel assigned to the Regional Defense Counsel, Headquarters and Service Battalion, Camp Pendleton, California. I am currently detailed to the case of U.S. v. SSgt Frank Wuterich. SSgt Wuterich is one of the Marines accused in the deaths of civilians in what has come to be known as the Haditha incident.
- 3. In February of 2007 I requested, and was approved for, a retirement date of 1 May 2008. I am not under any mandatory retirement provisions. In February and March of this year it became clear that the case of U.S. v. SSgt Wuterich would not be completed before 1 May 2008. I, therefore, requested a 1 month extension of my retirement date. My request was approved in early March of this year with a new retirement date set for 1 June 2008.
- 4. An appeal by the Government of a military judge's ruling has resulted in further delays of the case prompting the necessity of extending my time on active duty to avoid severing the attorney-client relationship and the appointing of new counsel. The appointment of new counsel would cause substantial delays because of the depth of preparation necessary to try this case.
- 5. A denial of this request would result in substantial delays in this very important case, a denial of SSgt Wuterich's right to counsel, and would harm the military justice process.
- 6. I am prepared to consider alternatives to modification of the retirement date, such as recall to active duty after retirement for the purpose of trying the case.

1. Per Chapter 2 of the reference, I request a modification of my retirement date from 1 June 2008 to 1 August 2008.

- 2. I am a military defense counsel assigned to Legal Services Support Group, I MLG, I MEF, Camp Pendleton California. I am currently detailed to the ease of U.S. v. SSgt Frank Winerich. SSgt Wuterich is one of the Marines accused in the deaths of civilians in what has come to be known as the Haditha incident.
- 3. In February of 2007 I requested, and was approved for, a retirement date of 1 May 2008. I am not under any mandatory retirement provisions. In February and March of this year it became clear that the case of U.S. v. SSgt Wuterich would not be completed before 1 May 2008. I, therefore, requested a 1 month extension of my retirement date. My request was approved in early March of this year with a new retirement date set for 1 June 2008.
- 4. An appeal by the Government of a military judge's ruling has resulted in further delays of the case prompting the necessity of extending my time on active duty to avoid severing the attorney-client relationship and the appointing of new counsel. The appointment of new counsel would cause substantial delays because of the depth of preparation necessary to try this case.
- A denial of this request would result in substantial delays in this very important case, a denial of SSgt Wuterich's right to counsel, and would harm the military justice process.
