
I retained your firm in March of this year to represent me in Merit System Protection Board proceedings pursuant to my wrongful termination from the Department of Commerce. The Firm accepted my case following 17 months of *pro se* representation during which I established *prima facie* cases for USERRA and marital status, age and EEO retaliation discriminations. I retained your firm at Mr. Eugene Fidel's recommendation, and because of your expertise in military, EEO and MSPB proceedings.

Since that time, Ms. D'Agostino has represented my interests. Unfortunately, I have found her services to be unacceptable. I have repeatedly and unsuccessfully attempted to resolve my concerns directly with her in person, on the phone and through multiple e-mails.
