Dear Mr. Burden:

We may withdraw from representation in this matter if you: insist upon presenting a claim or defense that is not warranted under existing law and cannot be supported by good faith argument for an extension, modification, or reversal of existing law; personally seek to pursue an illegal course of conduct; insist that the law firm pursue a course of conduct that is illegal or that is prohibited under the disciplinary rules; render it unreasonably difficult for us to carry out our employment; insist that we engage in conduct that is contrary to our judgment but not prohibited under the disciplinary rules; or deliberately disregard any agreement or obligation to us as to the timely payment of expenses or fees as required by this agreement for services rendered.

If at any time you become dissatisfied with our handling of this matter, you should not hesitate to notify us immediately so we might resolve the problem and maintain a good relationship with you. You may terminate our representation at any time. In the event of termination, you will be responsible for payment of any fees earned or expenses incurred.

We will use our best efforts in representing you in this matter, but you acknowledge that we can give no assurances as to the final outcome.

Congratulations! This is to confirm your selection in the Student Temporary Employment Program (STEP) to the position of Student Trainee, Survey Technician, GS-0817-05 Step 1, with a pay rate of \$16.10 per hour. Your duty station will be at the Colorado State Office located at 2850 Youngfield Street in Lakewood, Colorado. The tentative effective date of your STEP appointment is June 20, 2010. Please report to Human Resources on Monday, June 21, 2010 at 8:30 a.m.

This offer is contingent upon you passing a background investigation. There is a fingerprint chart (SF-87), Questionnaire for Non-Sensitive Positions (SF-85), and (OF-306) Declaration for Federal Employment in your packet. You will need to go to the nearest police department to complete the fingerprint chart. Please call me if you have any questions.

This is a temporary appointment not-to-exceed one year. However, it may be extended as long as you meet the requirements of the program and perform your duties accordingly.

As a federal employee, you will earn four hours of annual (vacation) leave and four hours of sick leave for each biweekly pay period if you are working a full-time schedule. The Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996, signed by the President April 26, 1996, establishes Direct Deposit as a permanent provision for the pay of all new Federal hires. Direct Deposit, also known as electronic fund transfer (EFT), is intended to streamline delivery of federal payments. 



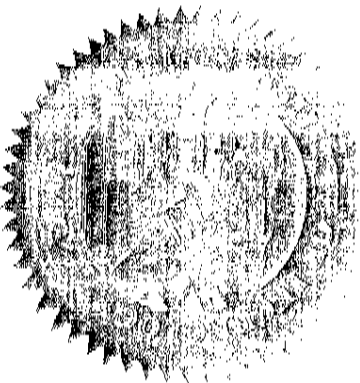
