GRANT OF TESTIMONIAL
IMMUNITY AND ORDER TO
TESTIFY

1. You are a material witness in the investigation and general court-martial involving the alleged sexual assault of Mrs. Ariana Klay by Captain James M. Rowe on or about 28 August 2010.

2. In consideration of your testimony as a witness in the matters described in paragraph (1), you are hereby granted immunity from the use of your testimony or other information given by you relating to the alleged sexual assault by Captain Rowe on or about 28 August 2010 from 2 December 2011, forward (including any evidence directly or indirectly derived from your testimony or from other information you provide); against you in any criminal case, except a prosecution for perjury, giving a false statement, or otherwise failing to comply with an order to testify in these matters.

3. It is understood that this grant of immunity from the use of your testimony or other information given by you relating to the alleged sexual assault by Captain Rowe on or about 28 August 2010 (including any evidence directly or indirectly derived from your testimony or other information you provide) cannot be used against you in any criminal case. The grant of immunity is effective only upon the condition that you cooperate fully in any and all pretrial interviews by investigators or counsel, and that you testify under oath as a witness at any hearing or court-martial in connection with these matters, if requested to do so.

4. This grant of immunity is made under the authority granted me under Rule for Courts-Martial 704, Manual for Courts-Martial, 2008, as a general courts-martial convening authority.

5. You are ordered to testify when called as a witness in any hearing or court-martial involving the matters described in paragraph (1). Additionally, having been granted immunity, you are ordered to answer questions put to you by investigators or counsel pursuant to this grant. Failure to comply with this order given by me or the order of others in furtherance of this order will subject you to prosecution for violating Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice.
