- 1. This advice is submitted in accordance with Rule for Courts-Martial 406 of reference (a) and Article 34 of reference (b). I have reviewed the enclosures pursuant to the references, and my advice follows.
- 2. ANALYSIS OF THE CHARGES AND SPECIFICATIONS. The accused is charged with the offenses indicated in enclosures (1) and (2). The specifications allege offenses under the punitive articles of reference (b) and, except as detailed below are warranted by the evidence indicated in enclosure (3).
- a. The evidence is insufficient to go forward on the specifications listed below. I recommend that the following specifications be dismissed without prejudice for the reasons indicated:
- (1) The sole specification of Charge II, willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer by speaking with potential witnesses. There is insufficient evidence to clearly establish that the accused spoke with the witnesses in question after receiving the order from LtCol Bond.
- (2) Specifications 1, 2, and 3 of Charge IV. The accused is charged with assaulting Ms. Jessica Brooder, Ms. Elizabeth Easley, and Ms. Nicole Cusack by drugging them with an intoxicant, a means likely to produce death or grievous bodily harm. The government must prove that:

(a) the accused attempted, offered, or did bodily harm to a certain person, (b) that he did so with a certain means, (c) that the attempt, offer, or bodily harm was done with unlawful force or violence, and (d) that the means was used in a manner likely to produce death or grievous bodily harm.

Despite diligent efforts by the forensic experts, the government has been unable to find any admissible evidence of an intoxicant.

- (3) Specification 4 of Charge V, indecent exposure. The government must prove:
 - (a) that the accused exposed a certain part of his body to public view in an indecent manner, (b) that the exposure was willful and wrongful, and (c) that under the circumstances the conduct was to the prejudice of good order and discipline in the armed forces or was of a nature to bring discredit upon the armed forces.

Neither Ms. Elizabeth Easley nor Ms. Jessica Brooder has any memory of actually seeing the indecent exposure. Without their testimony on this issue, there is insufficient evidence.

- (4) The sole specification under Additional Charge I, willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer by speaking with Ms. April Tatton. The accused responded to a question that Ms. Tatton posed to a crowd in the law school bookstore regarding the location of a book. There is insufficient evidence to establish willful disobedience.
- (5) Specification 5 of Additional Charge II, conduct unbecoming an officer and gentlemen in that the accused drank to excess in public. There is insufficient evidence to establish that the accused drank to excess. No witness can establish the amount of alcohol consumed or any drunken conduct.
- (6) Specification 6 of Additional Charge II, conduct unbecoming an officer and a gentleman in that the accused attempted to converse with several people listed on the no contact order. There is insufficient evidence to establish guilt regarding this specification.
- b. I recommend modifying Specifications 1, 2, and 7 of Additional Charge II, conduct unbecoming an officer and gentlemen by engaging in sexual contact after drugging the victims. The discussion above regarding insufficient evidence of an intoxicant applies here. I recommend that these three specifications be modified to read in pertinent part, that the accused "acted in a manner unbecoming of an officer and gentlemen, to wit: by engaging in (or attempting to engage) sexual intercourse with (name of victim) while he knew, or should have known that (name of victim) was so significantly intoxicated and mentally and physically impaired as a result of said

intoxication that a reasonable officer in the Naval service would have recognized that there was a substantial likelihood that she was incapable of knowingly and voluntarily consenting to sexual intercourse."

- 3. JURISDICTION. A General Court-Martial would have personal and subject matter jurisdiction over the accused and each offense alleged.
- 4. ARTICLE 32 INVESTIGATION. Per enclosure (2), the Investigating Officer recommends trial by General Court-Martial.
- 5. BATTALION COMMANDER'S RECOMMENDATION. In an abundance of caution, the Commanding Officer, Headquarters and Service Battalion, MCRD/WRR San Diego has forwarded this case without recommendation. This extraordinary step was taken to avoid any potential concerns regarding her prior involvement in the case as the Staff Judge Advocate. See enclosure (4). The Special Court-Martial Convening Authority and the Investigating Officer complied with requirements of references (a) through (c).
- 6. RECOMMENDATION. I have directed that new charges be preferred based upon the discussion above. See enclosure (5). I recommend that the charges and specifications contained in enclosure (5) be referred to a trial by General Court-Martial convened by enclosure (6). If you concur, please sign enclosure (5) where indicated.

Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near San Diego, California, from about April 2007 to about January 2009, on diverse occasions, wrongfully endeavor to influence the testimony of Joseph Gorman, as a witness before Special Agent J.R. Burge, Naval Criminal Investigative Service, an investigating officer in the case of Captain Douglas S. Wacker, U.S. Marine Corps, by asking Joseph Gorman to provide false statements to the said investigating officer.

Specification 2: In that Captain Douglas S. Wacker, United States Marine Corps, on active duty, did, at or near San Diego, California, From about April 2007 to about January 2009, wrongfully endeavor to impede the investigation in the case of Captain Douglas S. Wacker, U.S. Marine Corps, investigated by Special Agent J.R. Burge, Naval Criminal Investigative Service, by asking Mr. Amos Lowder to speak with Ms. Nicole Cusack, a potential victim, to keep Ms. Nicole Cusack quiet and to tell her to not talk to anyone about Captain Wacker's ongoing case with Ms. Easley and Ms. Brooder, or words to that effect.
