Specifically, because of her past training and Navy history involving her work with many rape victims CDR Robinson is able to explain whether procedures were properly followed or not following the rape allegations in this case as well as how investigations in sexual assault cases should reliably be done. Her testimony may tend to impeach the credibility of government witnesses, to include NCIS agents and the accusers regarding how rape victims typically act in such scenarios.
