and Notification of Initiation of Withdrawal of Federal Recognition**


1. In reference to the General Officer Memorandum of Reprimand, you have tendered your response and I have reviewed it carefully. In its essence, your response contains no acknowledgement of wrongdoing and offers only that you relied on others to your detriment. After reading your response, as a courtesy to you, I thoroughly re-read the 15-6 investigation. In light of the facts adduced in the investigation, I find your response to be unbelievable.

2. After consideration of all information relevant to this matter, listed below is my decision:

a. Your GOMOR will be filed in your unrestricted Official Military Personnel File as a permanent document.

b. I am in receipt of your "Election of Options" form as it pertains to Withdrawal of Federal Recognition and your decision noted therein not to resign, given that you have chosen not to resign, my headquarters will initiate the necessary actions and process to convene a board to determine whether or not your Federal Recognition will be withdrawn involuntarily.
