Subj: PUBLICATION OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

Ref: (a) SECNAVINST 5300.28D, Military Substance Abuse
Prevention and Control
(b) Uniform Code of Military Justice

Encl: (1) List of Prohibited Substances

1. Situation

a. A disturbing trend of substance abuse has surfaced throughout Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar and the surrounding San Diego area causing this command to prohibit the possession, sale, use, or distribution of certain legally obtainable substances.

b. The specific abuse at issue involves substances not currently controlled by the United States or otherwise prohibited by references (a) or (b).

c. Psychotropic effects similar to marijuana, Lysergic Acid Diethylamide (LSD), and other psychoactive substances have been reported from the substances listed in enclosure (1).

2. Mission. To prohibit the possession, sale, use or distribution of substances that are intended to produce a psychotropic or psychologically altered state when ingested or smoked.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. To ensure the health and mission readiness of all Marines and Sailors within the command, and to protect the welfare of all service members and dependents living and working onboard MCAS Miramar.

(2) Concept of Operations

(a) Definitions. "Psychotropic" and "Psychoactive" are terms to describe substances that affect the mind, mood, or other mental processes.

(b) Prohibitions

1. The substances listed in enclosure (1) have a high potential to affect the efficiency, mission readiness, discipline and good order of units stationed at MCAS Miramar. The uncontrolled nature of the substances makes them highly accessible and their unregulated and unpredictable nature make it likely that service members who use them will experience psychotropic or psychoactive effects. Service members will also likely suffer an adverse physical reaction or engage in some unlawful conduct due to impaired judgment.

2. The actual or attempted possession, use, sale, distribution or manufacture of any substance listed in enclosure (1), or any derivative, analogue, or variant of substances listed in enclosure (1), is prohibited.

3. Enclosure (1) will be periodically updated with notification of any other prohibited substances.


4. This Order is punitive in nature and violations of this Order may result in punitive or adverse administrative action under reference (b).

5. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to personnel assigned to Marine Corps Air Station Miramar.
