CHARGE I: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 92

Specification 1: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps, while on active duty, did, at or near Kansas City, Missouri, on or about 7 November 2009, violate a lawful general order, to wit: MCO 1000.9A dated 30 May 2006, by wrongfully stating to Ms. Laura Ogletree "You're done" or words to that affect after she refused to touch his groin area.


Specification 2: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps, while on active duty, did, at or near Kansas City, Missouri, between on or about July 2009 and April 2010, violate a lawful general order, to wit: Depot Order 1746.10N w/CH 1 dated 17 April 2008, by wrongfully consuming alcohol in a government building without prior authorization from the Commanding Officer.

CHARGE II: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 120

Specification 1: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps, while on active duty, did, at or near Kansas City, Missouri, on or about 7 November 2009, engage in sexual contact with Ms. Tina Vinson, to wit: touching her breast, and such sexual contact was without legal justification or lawful authorization and with the permission of Ms. Tina Vinson.

Specification 2: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps, while on active duty, did, at or near Kansas City, Missouri, on or about 7 November 2009, engage in sexual contact with Ms. Laura Ogletree, to wit: touching her breast, and such sexual contact was without legal justification or lawful authorization and with the permission of Ms. Laura Ogletree.

CHARGE III: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 128

Specification 1: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps, did at or near Kansas City, Missouri, on or about 7 November 2009, unlawfully grab the breast of Ms. Tina Vinson.

Specification 2: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps, did at or near Kansas City, Missouri, on or about 7 November 2009, unlawfully grab the breast of Ms. Laura Ogletree.

CHARGE IV: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 133

Specification 1: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps, was, at or near Kansas City, Missouri, on or about 7 November 2009, in a public place, to wit: the Marine Corps Ball, drunk and disorderly while in uniform, to the disgrace of the armed forces.

Specification 2: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps did, at or near Kansas City, Missouri, on or about 7 November 2009, in a public place, to wit: the Marine Corps Ball, wrongfully have sexual contact with Ms. Tina Vinson by touching her breast with his hands while in uniform, to the disgrace of the armed forces.

Specification 3: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps did, at or near Kansas City, Missouri, on or about 7 November 2009, in a public place, to wit: the Marine Corps Ball, wrongfully have sexual contact with Mrs. Laura Ogletree by touching her breast with his hands while in uniform, to the disgrace of the armed forces.

CHARGE V: VIOLATION OF THE UCMJ, ARTICLE 134

Specification: In that Major Carlos O. Rowe, United States Marine Corps, while on active duty, did, at or near Kansas City, Missouri, between on or about July 2009 and April 2010, wrongfully violate paragraph 1165 of the U.S. Navy Regulation dated September 1990, by fraternizing with his junior enlisted Marines in which conduct of the accused was to the prejudice of good order and discipline in the armed forces or was of a nature to bring discredit upon the armed forces.
