On March 3, 2010, you granted a two weeks extension until March 15, 2010, to submit rebuttal materials in this matter. That extension was requested by me because I believe PFC Colyer was denied access to certain good character and percipient witnesses on matters that are directly relevant to this proceeding. I sent a letter to BGEN Salazar and his SJA notifying them of my concerns. BGEN Salazar wrote back that he would conduct an inquiry into the matter. I have not yet heard back from the General. Accordingly, I request another two week extension until March 30, 2010, to provide time for the completion of the inquiry into witness tampering and denial of access to witnesses, before PFC Colyer submits rebuttal materials.
