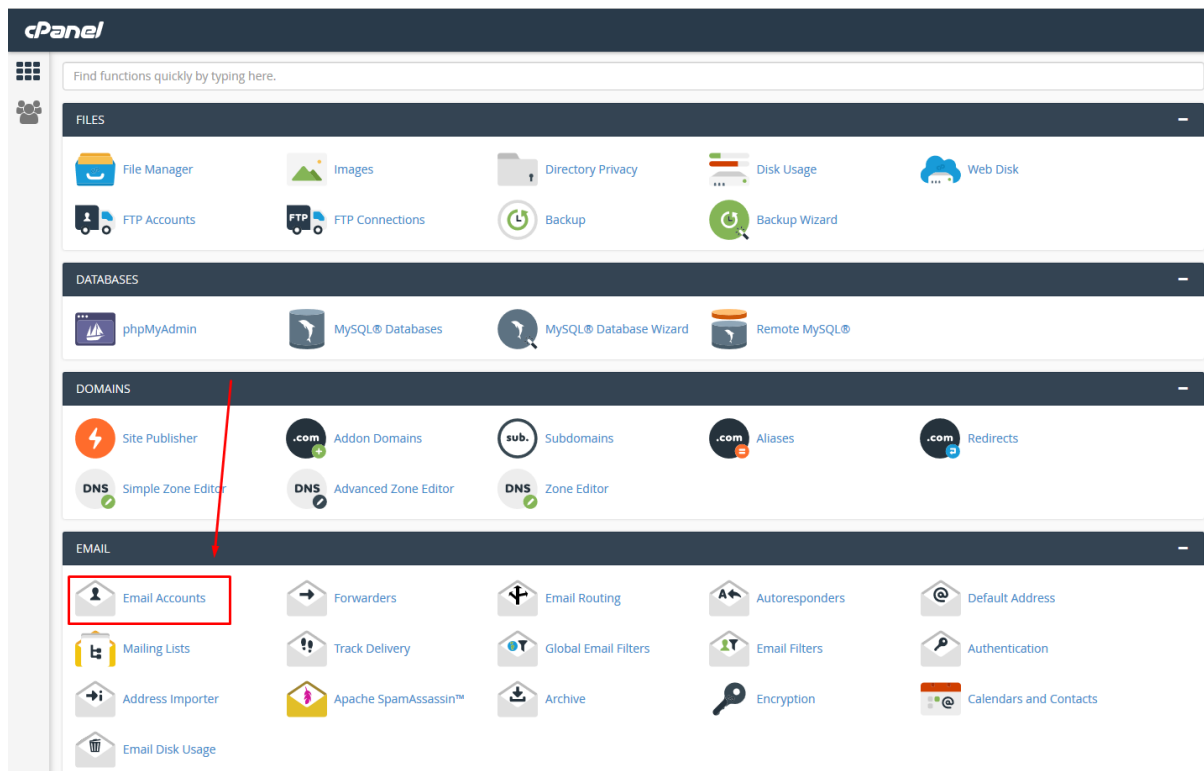



$config['title'] = "TMail Script";
$config['host'] = "mail.thehp.pro";
$config['user'] = "catchall@thehp.pro";
$config['pass'] = "password";
$config['domains'] = array("tmail1.tk", "tmail2.tk", "tmail3.tk", "tmail4.tk", "tmail5.tk");
?>
```

\$config['title'] - Enter the site title in first option

\$config['domains'] - Enter hostname provided by your Email / Hosting Provider

\$config['user'] - Enter email ID you created in #1

\$config['pass'] - Enter password you use to create the above email ID in #1

\$config['domains'] - Enter the domains separated by comma (,) under double quotes
